Breakfast with the Birds

Fun for all the family : Enjoy an exotic tropical buffet style breakfast, amongst the birds, there is also photo opportunities with a resident parakeet, all of this is in a beautiful rainforest setting at the Wildlife Habitat in Port Douglas, the wildlife park has various attractions including Kangaroos, wallabies, Crocodiles and koalas to see.

Breakfast is served between 8.00am – 10.30am every day.

Lunch with the Lorikeets

For those who do not wish to rise early enough to take breakfast with the birds, take in lunch with the lorikeets, a plentiful lunch surrounded by lorikeets who wander a fly freely around you. Various types of birds can be seen these include parrots, curlews, emus and various other species.

Lunch is served between 12.00 – 2.00pm every day.

Hartley's Crocodile Farm

With boardwalks and pathways leading you on a journey of discovery, Hartley's Crocodile Adventures has educational wildlife presentations on snakes cassowaries, koalas and much more Australian wildlife. There are various feeding displays; and for \$10, *YOU* can feed a crocodile - an experience not to be missed! Take a trip around the lagoon and watch the crocodile feeding up close. Lunch can be taken in the Lilies Restaurant overlooking the lagoon.
